



OUT-OF-STATE TUITION WAIVER FOR *MILITARY & OTHER MEMBERS OF A QUALIFYING FEDERAL SERVICE*

Waiver-Specific Eligibility and Documentation Requirements

Separated Military Personnel Waiver applicants must submit the document(s) below based on the waiver provision that are applying under:

A. Individuals who within thirty-six (36) months of separation from such service, enroll in an academic program and demonstrate intent to become domiciled in Georgia. This waiver may also be granted to their spouses and dependent children.

1. Copy of DD214 form (Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty) for verification of the sponsor's separation from active duty and for confirmation that the enrollment will occur within 36 months of the separation; and,
2. Documentation showing the student intends to establish domicile in Georgia such as:
 - Copy of a current lease or deed for a residence in Georgia
 - Copy of utility bills for a residence in Georgia
 - Copy of a current driver's license issued in Georgia
 - Copy of current vehicle registration issued in Georgia
 - Georgia state income tax return or tax transcript for the most recent tax year
 - Copy of voter registration issued in Georgia
 - Copy of utility bills for residence in Georgia The above must provide clear and convincing evidence that steps have been taken to establish Georgia as their domicile (permanent home).

B. Any separated service member or any student utilizing transferred VA educational benefits, and physically residing in the state is also eligible.

1. Copy of VA Certificate of Eligibility indicating the student is eligible;
2. Documentation showing that the student physically resides in Georgia such as:
 - Copy of current driver's license issued in Georgia
 - Copy of current vehicle registration issued in Georgia
 - Copy of current lease or deed for a residence in Georgia
 - Georgia state income tax return or tax transcript for the most recent tax year
 - Copy of voter registration issued in Georgia
 - Copy of utility bills for residence in Georgia

C. Any individual as described in U.S.C. 3679(c) – please contact the Office of Student Affairs for additional information if a separated military waiver applicant indicates they are an individual described under U.S.C. 3679(c) and they do not qualify under A or B waiver provisions.
